Page 445:

Chilopsis linearis (Cav.) Sweet subsp. arcuata (Fosberg) Henrickson, DESERT WILLOW. U.S.A. Arizona. Pima Co.: "Chilopsis saligna Don", Sand washes near Camp Lowell, 13 May & 27 Jul 1881, C. G. Pringle (VT). "Chilopsis saligna Don", Banks of streams [Rillito Valley], fr. 4 Aug 1884, C. G. Pringle (PH). Pima Co./Santa Cruz Co.: "Chilopsis saligna Don", Banks of streams [Santa Rita Mts], fls. 4 Jun 1884, C. G. Pringle (PH). Note: The two collections of 1884 are represented on a single label and counted as a single preparation.

Page 534:

Vauquelinia californica (Torr.) Sarg. subsp. californica, ARIZONA ROSEWOOD. U.S.A. Arizona. Pima Co.: "Vauquelinia torreyi Watson", Santa Catalina Mts, alt. 3000–5000 ft, 22 Jun & 31 Jul 1881, C. G. Pringle (VT). "Vauquelinia torreyi Watson", Santa Catalina Mts, Jun 1882, C. G. Pringle (F). "Vauquelinia torreyi Watson", Santa Catalina Mts, fls. 16 Jun 1884, C. G. Pringle (CM). Note: The collection of 22 Jun 1881 included flowering specimens from the south side of the Santa Catalina Mts, while the collection of 31 July 1881 included fruiting specimens from the west side of the range; they are counted as a single preparation.
